

Moving to London Checklist

THE ULTIMATE TO-DO AND TO-BUY LIST FOR MOVING TO LONDON

FIND A FLAT

- Choose a neighbourhood
- Contact an estate agent or search on SpareRoom, OpenRent, etc.
- Ask all the necessary questions:
 - Are utilities included in rent?
 - What is the average cost of bills?
 - Who pays the bills in the flat?
 - What is the landlord like? How much do you interact?
 - Does the landlord fix issues quickly?
 - How long have the other tenants lived there?
 - What are the other tenants like? Where do they work? What time do they come home from work and what do they like to do in the evenings?
 - How is the water pressure?
 - What's the area like? Are there things to do nearby?
 - Do the flatmates hang out or merely coexist?
 - Is the landlord good about returning deposits?
 - Is it quiet at night (outside and from flatmates)?
 - Do any flatmates smoke?
 - Is there a cleaner? How do you split chores?
 - What time do other flatmates use the bathroom in the morning?
 - When someone moves out, do the flatmates have to find a replacement or does the landlord take care of it?
- Make an offer
- Pay deposit and sign contract

VISAS

- Check for any visa requirements

MOVING ARRANGEMENTS

- Organise picking up keys from estate agent or landlord
- Buy boxes + packing tape
- Find and book a removals company
- Ship items (if required)
- Clean your old flat (or book cleaners)
- Arrange to drop off keys for old flat
- Request deposit back from former flat
